Bus Pick-Up Locations

When we take a motor coach as our means of transportation to various activities, we usually use two pick-up locations, basically one north-west and one east. It depends on the direction of the trip. The location of the pick-up for each activity will be stated in the respective descriptions. At the present time, we are using the following pick-up locations.

Note: On each activity, the arrival times are approximate.

EAST:

Taylor Square Shopping Center on Rt. 256 North. Park in the back of the Fifth Third Bank at 2883 Taylor Road. You will be in front of Marshall's and JoAnn Fabrics. Directions from I-70 East: Travel east on I-70 to exit 112B. The exit sign says Reynoldsburg West. (The exit is west when you start but you will enter on Rt. 256). Turn right (North) at the first right (0.2 miles) Turn left on Taylor Road. You are there.

NORTHWEST:

Olentangy Plaza, 5005 Olentangy River Road. Rt. 315 North to Bethel Road exit, turn left (west) onto Bethel Road. Go to the 2nd light and turn left into the parking area of Olentangy Plaza. Park in front of the access road. Do not park in front of MicroCenter.

Are you a tomato lover? The average American eats roughly 24 pounds of tomatoes per year! Reynoldsburg is known as "The Birthplace of the Tomato." The tomato was 'born' in Reynoldsburg in the 19th century with the help of local favorite son Alexander W. Livingston. Livingston developed the 'Paragon Tomato,' billed as the first ever tomato bred for commercial use. His legacy lives on in the Livingston House and Museum on Graham Road, which is listed on the National Registry of Historic Homes.

Step back in time at Piatt Castle. Enjoy a facilitated self-guided journey through historical artifacts, photographs, exhibits, and explanatory text. Guest chairs are located in every area so visitors can relax and enjoy the setting or engage with hands-on activities.

From there we will enjoy a buffet lunch in the charming village of West Liberty, at the Liberty Gathering Place. Just up the street is Marie's Candies, a family chocolate shop since 1956. Housed in a restored 1920's train depot, view a video of their storied history and receive a small box of the mouth-watering chocolate!

Next we travel to The Cedar Bog Nature Preserve. Visit the Nature Center and learn why this is actually a fen, misnamed as a bog. Stroll along the 1.2 mile accessible boardwalk, look for an endangered Elfin Skimmer dragonfly or a five-lined skink. Or simply enjoy sitting on the deck overlooking the bog. See why the Cedar Bog is a National Natural Landmark.

A short drive will take us to the Johnny Appleseed Educational Center and Museum. Explore the world's largest collection of memorabilia and written information about the life of John "Appleseed" Chapman. Visit the Memorial Orchard with apple trees directly descended from those planted by Johnny Appleseed.
